A. **Transportation Fleet Report**

Peter Tunny, Transportation Supervisor, reviewed the 2008 transportation proposition for bus replacement, including fleet replacement schedule.

B. **Capital Project Update**

Beverly Miller presented an update on the Capital Project progress during the summer and also presented plans for the fall and winter months. The high school press box status was also discussed.

C. **Physical Education District Plan**

David Foust, Supervisor of Physical Education & Athletics, and Matt Stein, administrative intern and physical education teacher, reviewed the Physical Education District Plan, which is listed at Item #11 in these minutes for adoption by the Board of Education.

The rate for the services will be \$58.00 per half hour for individual, and \$43.00 per half hour per child for group sessions, and \$175.00 per supplemental evaluation.
2. A contract between St. Catherine's Center Day Treatment Program, 40 North Main Avenue, Albany NY 12203, and South Colonie Central School District to provide services for South Colonie resident students.
3. A contract with Wildwood Programs to provide educational services for six (6) South Colonie resident students for July & August 2008 at the interim rate of \$6,893.00 per student.
