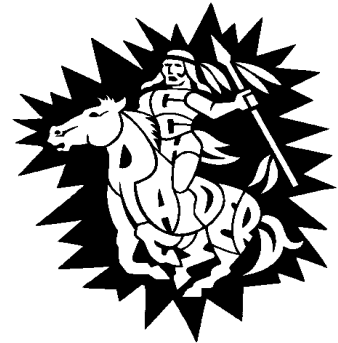

What this means is that the CPI-U was not a high enough increase (May 2009 compared to May 2008) to qualify for any increase for extensions of pupil transportation contracts. It does not mean that school districts can require contractors to lower their prices for the next school year by the negative amount. So the CPI for 2009-10 pupil transportation contracts is 0%.
