

Dear Kindergarten Students and Parents,



Welcome to Kindergarten! We are listing a few items that you will need for the beginning of school. You will need:

- Basic KinderMat: Red/Blue, 5 mil vinyl cover without pillow section (folds 12" x 20") @ School Specialty or Classroom Direct, Phone: 1-888-388-3224/ List Price: \$11.88
- A backpack: big enough to hold a folder, a lunch box, sneakers, etc...(NO WHEELS, PLEASE)
- A lunch box or bag labeled with your child's name
- A change of clothes in a Ziploc bag, labeled with your child's name
- A daily **peanut-free**, nutritious snack such as raisins, fruit, vegetables, cheese, crackers, etc.
- A beverage for snack time (no glass bottles)
- 2 marble composition notebooks (please no spiral)
 - print your child's name on each notebook
 - label one notebook "Homework"
 - label one notebook "Poems"

The following items on this list will become community items. Please do not put your child's name on them!

- 2 boxes of **unscented**, Crayola crayons (a box of 16 is usually large enough)
- 10 glue sticks
- 1 box of tissues
- 12 sharpened pencils (Ticonderoga brand)
- Package of 8 Washable, **unscented**, Crayola markers
- Washable, **unscented**, Crayola THIN markers
- 1 sponge
- 1 container of playdoh (5 ounce-any color)
- 1 roll of paper towels

*****Please note: The day before the official first day of school, you will have the opportunity to ride the bus or walk to school for a brief visit to our classroom. We would appreciate it if you could bring ALL of the supplies on that day. At some point during the year we may ask for supplies to be replenished.**

Dear Parents and Students,

Welcome to First Grade! To help us get off to a great start, please send the following items to school with your child:

1. A backpack or book bag (please label with your child's name)
2. One large box of Crayola crayons (no larger than a 24 count)
3. One pencil box large enough to hold glue, pencils, and crayons (*not* an 8" x 11" size)
4. At least one package of *sharpened #2 Ticonderoga* brand pencils
5. At least eight large *Elmer's* glue sticks
6. Washable magic markers-classic colors
7. One pocket folder - labeled with your child's name
8. One marble composition notebook-labeled with your child's name
9. Two boxes of tissues
10. Gel pens (small pack)
11. 1-2 dry erase markers (low odor)
12. 2 yellow highlighters
13. Scissors (blunt tip- *Fiskars* brand)
14. Clipboard with a flat top (available at the Dollar Store)
15. One box of gallon size *ziplock* baggies
16. 1 package of 3x3 Post-It notes

*** *Optional, but very helpful:*

- Colored paper lunch bags
- Sandwich size Ziploc bags

These items should be brought in during the **first** day of school. *Enjoy the rest of the summer!* We'll see you in September! Thank you.

Dear Second Grader,

We hope you have a fun-filled summer and we are looking forward to meeting you in September. Below is a list of materials you will need to bring in for the first day of school:

- 12 *sharpened* pencils (plain yellow is preferred)
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 gel pen (any color but yellow or black)
- 1 box of crayons (no larger than 24-count)
- 1 box of colored pencils (sharpened)
- 1 package of washable markers (thin tip only)
- 3 Expo dry-erase markers (any color but yellow)
- 1 pencil sharpener with a cover (electric sharpeners are not allowed)
- 2 large pink erasers
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 package of 3x3 Post-It Notes
- 1 pencil box (large enough to hold all of the above materials)
- 1 backpack (without wheels preferred)
- 1 folder with horizontal pockets (any color or design except green)
- 1 box of tissues

On the first day of school we will be collecting and storing some of these materials. Please remove all your materials from their packaging before you bring them to school. Mid-year you may receive a letter to help us replenish any materials that we need. Have fun packing up your pencil box and book bag! September will be here before you know it!

Welcome to Third Grade!



Here are the supplies your third grader will need:

- **3 Single Subject Spiral Notebooks - Red, Green, and Yellow.**
- **5 Pocket Folders - Red, Green, Blue, Yellow and Purple.**
- **2 Marble Composition Notebooks**
- **1 Clipboard - Please try to find the kind with the flat clip at the top as these will fit in the desks better.**

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL ALL BE COMMUNITY SUPPLIES:

- **2 dozen pencils (sharpened please)**
- **1 good rubber eraser (not the kind for the top of the pencil)**
- **24 count of crayons**
- **12 count of colored pencils**
- **3 Glue Sticks - We have liquid glue!**
- **2 Dry Erase Markers**
- **1 Box of Tissues**
- **1 Box of Ziploc bags (gallon or quart size)**
- **1 clean sock (to be used as an eraser for dry-erase boards)**
- **1 pair of scissors**
- **1 highlighter**

- One expandable file folder with only 5 pockets (these come with a clip to close them or even an elastic cord) Please label the 5 pockets with the following subjects:
 1. ELA/Spelling
 2. Math
 3. Social Studies
 4. Science
 5. Other
- 2 composition notebooks – Please label one for ELA and one for Writing
- 2 single subject, non-perforated, spiral bound notebooks – Please label one for Math, one for Social Studies, & one for Science
- 1 folder
- 3 packages of blue or black ERASABLE pens
- 1 package of 10 sharpened pencils
- 1 pencil/pen pouch (boxes do not fit in the desks)
- 2 yellow highlighters
- 3 **LOW ODOR** dry erase markers – Black
- 2 old, clean socks
- 1 –8 count package of crayons, a pair of scissors and a glue stick
- 1 3x3 package of sticky notes
- 2 boxes of 100 count tissues
- 1 container of anti-bacterial wipes
- \$4.00 in an envelope labeled with your name, for your homework planner.
- 1 **SMALL, HEALTHY** snack (and water if you choose). We'll be going to lunch at 12:27 p.m.
