Mrs. Hoffman's List

- backpack (label with child's name)
- 20 pencils (**sharpened**)
- scissors (Fiskar brand is best)
- 1 package no/low odor dry erase markers
- 1 package of **washable** markers
- 2 - 2 pocket folders (laminated last longest, label with child's name)
- 7 boxes of 8 Crayola crayons (regular size not fat)
- 20 glue sticks
- 2 highlighter markers
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 package of 3x5 index cards
- 1 clipboard

- 1 photo of something you did over the summer (label with child's name)

a large t-shirt for painting (at least several sizes too large for easy handling)

****It is only necessary to label those items that are indicated.**

The majority of our supplies are community supplies.

****Please bring your supplies to school on Bus Orientation Day.**

****This may seem like a lot however last year no extra supplies were needed during the school year!**

Mrs. Wagner's List

The following items do not need to be labeled with your child's name. They will be used as community supplies.

- 5 boxes of 8 Crayola crayons. (regular size)
- 8 sharpened pencils
- 12 large glue sticks (solid type)
- 1 bottle of Elmer's school glue
- 3 highlighter markers
- 1 clean sock or small piece of fabric to use as an eraser
- 1 pkg. of low odor dry erase markers
- 1-boxed snack (for when kids forget) ex. (Goldfish, cookies, pretzels)
- 1 package of 3x5 index cards
- 1 pair of Fiskar scissors

- Girls-1 pkg. Crayola washable markers-thick
- 1 box of Kleenex
- 1 box of zip-loc bags-2gal.size

- Boys-1 pkg. Crayola washable markers-thin
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 box of zip-loc bags-1gal.size

Please label the below items with your child's name

- 2 horizontal pocket folders
- 1 large zipper style backpack
- 1 clipboard
- A large t-shirt for painting (at least several sizes too large for easy handling)

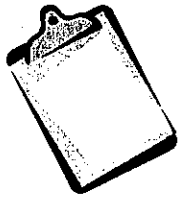
Mr. Wright's List

- 2 containers of Elmer's brand washable school glue in the 4 oz. size, white
- 1 spiral notebook, 50 or more pages
- 2 folders

In kindergarten, the children share many supplies, such as the glue you will be sending to school. Other supplies stay at school for your child to use in kindergarten, such as the spiral notebook. Some supplies go home each day, such as the folder.

Please provide your child with the following items:

- Backpack with your child's name on it
- Container to hold lunch and classroom snack

Please label each item below with your child's name:

- 1 box of washable markers (primary colors/broad tip)
- 1 box of 16 crayons
- 1 9x12 clipboard
- 1 change purse for holding lunch money (if needed)
- 1 book bag
- 1 5x8 snap shut pencil box
- Green, purple, red, yellow and blue 2 pocket folders – 1 each (plastic preferred for durability)
- 1 1-inch 3 ring binder (no Trapper Keepers, please)
- 1 folder of your choice

Please do not label the items below. We will be sharing these items with our classroom family throughout the year:

- 40 sharpened yellow pencils
- 6 jumbo glue sticks
- 1 bottle of liquid glue
- 1 large box of Kleenex
- 4 pink erasers (girls only)
- dry erase markers (boys only)
- 1 marble composition notebook
- 1 box of one –gallon size Ziploc bags (boys only)
- 1 box of one –quart size Ziploc bags (girls only)
- 1 highlighter
- 1 clean, old sock (to use as an eraser with the dry erase marker)



Please remove items from their packaging. This makes it much easier to get our desks organized on the first day of school.

- 3 - 10 or 12 count packs of pencils. Please sharpen!
- 1 box of 24 crayons (max)
- scissors (pointed)
- 3 large glue sticks
- 1 set of washable markers (primary colors/broad tip)
- 2 broad tip, low odor dry erase markers
- 9x12 clipboard
- 1 plastic, snap-shut type pencil box (5x8)
- 2 large boxes of tissues
- 1 box slide lock plastic bags (girls-gallon size and boys quart size)
- 1 pink eraser
- 1 box baby wipes (girls only)
- 1 pkg. of at least 200 post its (boys only)
- 6 bottom pocket folders (1 of each color: orange, red, blue, green, yellow, purple). Plastic or laminated work best!
- 2 plastic bottom pocket folders (for heavy use) any color!
- 2 marble composition notebooks
- 1 yellow highlighter
- 1 small washable liquid school glue

4th Grade Supply List for 2010-2011 School Year

- 1 laminated two-pocket folder
 - label folder with your name and "Take Home Folder"
- 1 plastic expandable file folder with at least 6 pockets with tabs
 - label tabs in the following order:
Math, Science, SS, Reading, Writing and Spelling
- 1 spiral notebook (*100 pages or more*)
 - label notebook with your name and "Math"
- 1 composition notebook
 - put your name on the inside cover, do not label the front
- 25 No. 2 pencils (*plain pencils, sharpened would be helpful but not necessary*)
- 1 large "pink" eraser and/or 1 package of pencil eraser toppers
- 2 ballpoint pens (*blue or black ink, can be erasable*)
- 1 colored pen (*any color other than blue or black for correcting papers*)
- 1 box of markers *OR* 1 box of crayons
- 2 large glue sticks
- 1 large box of tissues
- 1 small soft-sided zipper pencil case (*to store pens and pencils in your desk - all other supplies will be kept elsewhere*)
- 1 pair of pointed scissors that cut well
- 1 clipboard
