

RESPONSIBILITY OF COMPONENT SCHOOL BOARD

The Board of Education recognizes the value which the Albany-Schoharie-Schenectady Board of Cooperative Educational Services (BOCES) offers in providing expanded educational and business services to this District. The Board elects to participate as a component member of the BOCES. In accordance with law, the Board shall participate in the election of the BOCES Board and the vote on the administrative budget.

The election of BOCES Board members and the vote on the BOCES budget will take place at either a regular or special meeting held between April 16 and April 30 on a date designated by the BOCES.

Election of BOCES Board

Nominations shall be submitted to the Clerk of the BOCES no later than thirty (30) days prior to the date of the election. No more than one member may be nominated to serve from this District unless the number of Board seats exceeds the number of component districts.

BOCES Board members are elected by vote on the Component Boards. Election ballots will be sent to the District by the BOCES. The Board shall cast one vote for each vacancy, but in no case more than one vote for each candidate. Each member shall be elected for a term of three (3) years, unless otherwise directed by the BOCES.

BOCES Budget

The BOCES administrative, capital and program budgets shall be presented to the component Boards at a meeting held on or before April 15. At a public meeting on the same date designated for the election of BOCES Board members, the Board shall adopt a resolution approving or disapproving the tentative administrative budget.

The District shall make budgets available to District residents upon request.
