

BOARD COMMITTEES

The President of the Board of Education has the power and authority to appoint standing committees authorized by the Board. The function of all committees shall ordinarily be fact-finding, deliberative and advisory. Their reports shall be made to the Board for discussion and action.

The President and the Superintendent of Schools, or the Superintendent's designee, shall be ex-officio members of all committees.

Committees shall be established as soon as possible after the annual re-organizational meeting of the Board in areas of:

1. Academic Achievement
2. Accountability & Board Operations
3. Audit/Finance
4. District Communications
5. Facilities
6. Graduation/Hall of Fame
7. Information Technology
8. Policy
9. Strategic Planning
10. Transportation

Special temporary committees of the Board may be appointed by the President for any purpose approved by the Board. Appointments to these committees shall be approved by the Board and shall be discharged upon completion of their assignments.
