

**ANNUAL MEETING**

**SUBMISSION OF PROPOSITIONS BY QUALIFIED VOTERS**

- A. No question or proposition may be placed on the ballot or voted upon at an annual meeting of the school district unless same is presented by petition subscribed to by qualified voters of the District equal to five percent (5%) of those who voted in the last annual election or twenty-five (25) qualified voters, whichever is greater, and filed with the Clerk of the Board of Education not later than thirty (30) calendar days before the meeting or election.
  
- B. No question or proposition may be placed on the ballot and voted upon where said question or proposition is required by law to be stated in the published notice of the meeting.
