

**ALLOCATION OF SPACE FOR
SPECIAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS AND SERVICES**

Pursuant to 8 NYCRR § 200.2(c), the Board of Education is required, if receiving an apportionment for eligible students with disabilities, to prepare a District-wide plan every two (2) years containing appropriate space for Special Education programs and services, and adopt a written policy to this effect.

To ensure that adequate and appropriate space is available for Special Education classes provided by the District, as well as programs provided by the Board of Cooperative Education Services (BOCES), the Board of Education shall allocate an appropriate amount of space in District facilities to meet the needs of students and preschool students in such programs. This allocation will be part of the bi-annual District plan for the provision of Special Education programs and services, as mandated by the Commissioner of Education.

Accordingly, the policy contained herein shall fulfill the requirement of the Commissioner of Education in adopting the Special Education space allocation program.
