

BUDGET HEARING

The Board of Education will hold an annual budget hearing at which it will present a detailed proposed budget for the following school year. The purpose of the budget hearing is to inform the public of the contents of the budget and to provide an explanation and justification for the decisions the proposed budget reflects.

The budget hearing will be held not less than seven (7) nor more than fourteen (14) days prior to the Annual District Meeting at which the District's voters will vote on the budget. The proposed budget shall be completed at least seven (7) days before the budget hearing. The proposed budget may be obtained by any taxpayer or any other District resident at each school during the designated hours specified on each day during the fourteen (14) day period immediately preceding the Annual District Meeting and election.

Notice of the date, time, and place of the annual budget hearing shall be contained in the notice of the Annual Meeting.
