

**SMOKING OR USE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS IN  
SCHOOL FACILITIES, BUILDINGS, GROUNDS, AND VEHICLES**

No smoking or use of any tobacco products will be permitted within any indoor facility, school property, or school vehicle owned, leased or contracted for and utilized by the South Colonie Central Schools for provision of routine or regular Kindergarten, elementary, or secondary education, library services, or other services to children during school hours and during any student activity that is supervised by faculty or staff or any officially sanctioned school event with or without students.

For purposes of this policy, the term “indoor facility” shall mean a building that is enclosed. The term “school property” shall mean both buildings and legally defined grounds. The term “vehicle” shall mean any bus, car, truck, van or motorized vehicle owned, leased or contracted for by the District.
