Group Basic Life Insurance

Basic Life insurance from The Standard Life Insurance Company of New York helps provide financial protection by promising to pay a benefit in the event of an insured member's covered death.

The cost of this insurance is paid by South Colonie Central School District.

Eligibility

Definition of a Member

You are a member if you are a non-teaching Administrator who retired prior to 07/01/88; Support Supervisor who retired on or before 06/30/91; United Public Service employee or Confidential District employee who attained age 55 or more and had either 10 years of service at retirement and retired prior to 07/01/13, had between 10 and 15 years of service at retirement and retired on or after 07/01/13, or had attained age 55 or more and had 15 or more years of service at retirement on or after 07/01/13 of South Colonie Central School District.

Class Definition

Class 9 Retired United Public Service employees who attained age 55 or more and had either 10 years of service at retirement and retired prior to July 1, 2013 or had between 10 and 15 years of service at retirement and retired on or after July 1, 2013

Eligibility Waiting Period

You are eligible on the date you retire.

Benefits

Basic Life Coverage Amount

Your Basic Life coverage amount is \$15,000.

Age Reductions

Your Basic Life coverage amount reduces to \$10,000 at age 65 and then to \$5,000 at age 71.

Other Basic Life Features
