

UNEXPIRED TERM FULFILLMENT

In the event of a vacancy on the Board of Education by reason of death, resignation, removal from office, or moving from the school district, the Board shall appoint a qualified person to fill the vacancy within ninety (90) days. The person so appointed in the place of any such member of the Board shall hold office only until the next regular school district election. A vote of the majority of the whole Board is required to fill a vacancy by appointment. The person elected to fill such vacancy shall take office immediately upon filing of his official oath of office with the District Clerk.

If the Board fails to fill the vacancy within ninety (90) days, the District (BOCES) Superintendent may fill it by appointment in school districts under his/her jurisdiction.
