4. SUPERINTENDENT UPDATE

Dr. Perry stated that school is off to a great start. Currently we have 4 active cases. The report of transmission has been limited at this point. Thank you to everyone for being proactive. The state is requiring all staff to be vaccinated or have weekly COVID testing. We are hoping to start this process in early October. Students will also be tested. We will give notice and will not test students without parental consent. Our opening message this year focused on the four pillars. Our strategic plan is a work in progress this school year. We are excited to have all of our kids back in school this year.

Ms. Gigliello attended the Blue Star Mothers of America remembrance ceremony honoring the memories of lives lost in the 2001 terrorist attacks and said it was a beautiful and emotional ceremony.

WHEREAS, the cost of the Tractor is Eighty Four Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars and Fifty Three Cents (\$84,700.53); and

WHEREAS, the amount to be financed through MLC's lease-purchase agreement with the District is Eighty Four Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars and Fifty Three Cents (\$84,700.53) to be paid for a term of four (4) years, with an interest rate of 2.929%; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS:

RESOLVED, that Municipal Leasing Consultants is the most responsible bidder for the leasepurchase - of the Kubota Utility Tractor; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the President of the South Colonie Central School District Board of Education is authorized to sign all documents required for this transaction.
